INFORMATION ABOUT OUR CLASSES: Descriptive information for all of our February-March-April classes, along with dates and times, is included in this Newsletter. The same information, along with pictures of the Class Models, can be found on our website. The dropdown CLASSES menu at the top of our Home page will take you to 3 pages: BASIC SKILLS CLASSES, FAVORITE CLASSES, and NEW CLASSES. If you are new to quilting or want to sharpen some of your skills, we encourage you to go to our BASIC SKILLS CLASSES page. Our FAVORITE CLASSES have been offered before (in some cases, over and over!). The classes on our NEW CLASSES page are being offered for the first time in our shop (or offered again after a long hiatus).

CLASSES SIGN UP DAY: Classes Sign Up Day is the first Saturday of February, February 3. We shall discount by 10% the class fee for each class that you sign up for on/or before that day.

BOM SHOW WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 14 THROUGH THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 22

Our Block of the Month program for the *Red & White* laptop quilt drew to a close in November. The quilts you have finished during this program will be on display in our "Block of the Month Laptop Quilt Show", Wednesday, February 14 through Thursday, February 22. Although our shop model was done in red and white, we are thrilled to report that quilts in other color ways have also been made and will be on display during this show. Awards will include a \$75 Gift Card.

2018 EMPLOYEE QUILT SHOW: Monday April 2 through Sunday, April 15. Mark your calendars to see the quilts that represent the hearts and souls of our staff.

OUR BLOCK-OF-THE-MONTH PROGRAMS:

2018-19 Red & White Queen-Sized Quilt, 90" × 107": This is a follow-on to our 2016-17 *Red & White* Block-of-the-Month program: A pieced border is added to our lap-sized quilt to form a queen-sized quilt. The border has 26 pieced blocks, set "straight" (while the blocks in the lap quilt are on point). The program started in January and runs for 10 months. Patterns for 3 blocks are published each month; the setting instructions will be published in October. As in our "typical" BOM programs, the patterns are free during the month in which they are published. Twenty kits are prepared each month, and are available for the first 20 people who sign up for this program. Participants are expected to save their receipts (in Red Envelopes) and exchange them, at no additional cost, for 3 yards of Kona *Snow* fabric for setting the blocks in the borders next October.

2018 Shooting Stars Quilt, 92" × 104": The *Shooting Stars* Block-of-the-Month program was designed by Patrick Lose, and features pieced blocks created with beautifully bright fabrics from his *Basically Patrick* collection. This 10 month program started in January; the pattern for each block is free during the month dedicated to that block, and will be available at a nominal cost throughout the rest of the program. Kits will be available in addition to the patterns.

2018-19 Floral Menagerie Quilt, 72" × 96": The *Floral Menagerie* is a 12-month Block-of-the-Month program, starting in February, in which you frame 12 different animals (appliquéd to the background fabric), with pieced blocks. The bright fabrics belong to the *Floral Menagerie* collection from In The Beginning Fabrics, and are used to piece a unique frame for each month. This program differs from our other BOM programs in that you will be expected to purchase the pattern for the entire quilt at the beginning of the program. The kits for each month will *not* include the pattern (but will include amendments generated by our shop).

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FIRST FRIDAY SEW-IN: The dates are February 9 (note: second Friday of this month), March 2, and April 6. Join us at 5:30 for three hours in which we devote ourselves to *your* quilting projects. They can be UFOs, quilts on which you are “stuck”, etc. It is a full spectrum opportunity, all the way from the design of quilts to putting on the finishing touches. You are welcome to work on your own projects throughout the evening, and/or spend some time sewing (sharpening your skills, perhaps) on our charity quilts. There is no charge.

2018 ROW-BY-ROW EXPERIENCE™: The theme is “Sew Musical.” Mark Thursday, June 21, on your calendar. Plan on coming to *The Quilt Works* on that day to get your free pattern or purchase a kit for our 2018 row. Our license plates, featuring Sunbonnet Sue, and “DO MI SEW DO”, have already been drafted.

ALBUQUERQUE MODERN QUILT GUILD SEW DAY: *The Quilt Works* is hosting the Albuquerque Modern Quilt Guild’s February Sew Day on Saturday, February 3, 9:30-4:30. Members of the Albuquerque Modern Quilt Guild are welcome to join us for this event. The cost is \$10 for the whole day or \$5 for a half day. ELECTRIC QUILT: We have used Electric Quilt at *The Quilt Works* since shortly after “day 1” (1991) and gained a wealth of experience with this software. During the past two years, we have hosted the New Mexico Electric Quilt Club (NMEQ) meetings on the last Sunday of the month. With this information in mind, please note the following items.

- (1) Although we do not have a commitment from the NMEQ Club to use the times, we are holding the last Sundays of the month open for future meetings of the Club.
- (2) For updated information about the NMEQ Club activities, go to the Club website: www.nmeqclub.org.
- (3) In response to requests from our customers, we are introducing a basic EQ class which we shall simply call *Introduction to Electric Quilt*. This is a hands-on class. Students enrolled in the class will bring their laptop computers with EQ5, EQ6, EQ7, or EQ8 installed and will engage in learning experiences that give them the confidence to use their EQ software to create their own designs both of blocks and of quilts.

DUKE CITY APPLIQUÉ SOCIETY: If your passion is hand appliqué, join us on the second Sunday of each month, 1:00-3:00. The dates are February 11, March 11, and April 8. VIQ (VERY IMPORTANT QUILTER) CARDS: Every time you purchase full-price merchandise valued at more than \$5, we stamp your VIQ card. Your completed VIQ card (\$250) is doubly valuable. A completed Card can be redeemed for \$25 toward the purchase of full-price merchandise. The redeemed cards are held until January 1 or July 1, at which time we draw one card, and present the winner with a gift card valued at \$75.00. (We do not stamp the VIQ cards for classes, half-priced merchandise, or sale purchases.)

BIRTHDAY DISCOUNT: Be sure to shop on your birthday: You will receive a 25% discount on all full-price merchandise purchased on that day. (Special arrangements will be made if your birthday falls on a day when the shop is closed.) We do not stamp your VIQ card when you take advantage of this discount.

STUDENT DISCOUNT COUPON – 20%: As an additional incentive to take classes at *The Quilt Works*, we offer Student Discount Coupons. This Coupon entitles you to a one-time 20% discount on full-price merchandise, and is valid for one month. You will receive this Coupon at the first class meeting. (*Basic Rotary Skills* and visiting instructor classes are excluded. VIQ cards are not stamped when you use the Student Discount Coupon.)

SENIOR DISCOUNT DAY: Don’t forget that each Tuesday is a “Senior Discount Day.” Your senior discount (for those 60 and older) is 10%. (VIQ cards are not stamped.)

GIFT CARDS: Gift Cards make great presents, and may be purchased at the front desk. You may choose any value for your card.

BASIC ROTARY SKILLS * LAURA ECHEVERRIA AND DANA BRABSON (This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.) Rotary cutting makes quilt making quick and enjoyable. This class will show you correct techniques.

LET'S GET STARTED * DANA BRABSON (This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.) Not sure about the "quilter's scant quarter inch" seam allowance? Need to know about "nesting seams"? Let's get started! This course takes you from the Basic Rotary Skills class to the Introduction to Machine Piecing class. We'll also learn about the quarter inch foot, the walking foot, and about the fabrics, threads, and batting that are best for your quilting project. Note: You must bring your own sewing machine to this class. 2½ hrs: \$20.00.

INTRODUCTION TO MACHINE PIECING * DANA BRABSON This basic class introduces you to machine piecing techniques and gives you the experience you need to take any other *Quilt Works* class. You make a different block in each of the first 4 classes, and then quilt and bind a placemat in the 5th class. The placemats are 18" × 12". If you choose to create a table runner with the 4 blocks, it is 63" × 18". A wall hanging with the 4 blocks finishes at 33" × 33", and can be used as a nice table topper. *The "Let's Get Started" class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for this class.* 10 hrs: \$80.00.

What could be easier than stitching along preprinted straight lines with your machine? When you have finished this little quilt, you will feel confident with any paper pieced pattern. 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BINDING BASICS * DANA BRABSON Baffled with finishing your quilt? Let Dana show you the basics of finishing the edges of quilts, including bump-free joinings, and some decorative edges. This is a must for every quilter.

A-MAZING ** DANA BRABSON The A-Mazing Quilt can serve both as a crib quilt and as a play mat. If you have some fabrics with fun critters (kitties, dogs, characters from the Oz books, etc.) that can be fussy-cut to yield patches 5" x 5" with seam allowance, you can create a maze. Stop and visit the critters as you find your way along the red-brick road through the maze. We shall sew the strip sets, make a few blocks, and then pay a lot of attention to the strategy for pressing the seams so that the bulk in the seams is minimized.

Dana has made the gentle curves easy to sew with room to trim down after sewing. After learning the basic techniques, we’ll spend time exploring some of the unique designs. The quilt may be made in any size, lap to king. A note from Becky Welch: I recently took this class and was blown away by the engineering of the templates, the block construction technique (there is a trick that makes it easier than it looks!), and especially the enormous design potential. This class should not be missed!

Be sure to study the pattern in advance to make sure that you bring the right fabrics; Dana can help you with this.

Note (2): Sign up at least a week in advance so that we can order the hardware and other specialty items needed for this project. 6 hrs: \$48.00 for the class plus \$147.00 for the kit (VIQ eligible; includes pattern, hardware, and specialty fabrics).
