CLOSURES: Thanksgiving, Thursday, November 22; Christmas Day, Tuesday, December 25, and New Year's Day, Tuesday, January 1, 2019. We shall close at 2:00 pm on Wednesday, November 21, Monday, December 24, and Monday, December 31.

CLASSES SIGN UP DAY: Classes Signup Day is the last Saturday of October, the 27th. We shall discount by 10% the class fee for each class that you sign up for on/or before that day.

DEMO DAYS – FRIDAY & SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 9 & 10: Our staff and guest artists will be on hand to present 15- and 30-minute demonstrations of new designs, notions, techniques, and much more. Two demos will run in parallel starting at 10:00 and ending at 4:00, with a one-hour break for lunch. You will receive a ticket for each demo you attend and a ticket for each \$10 in purchase of full-price merchandise. We shall draw a ticket each hour for a door prize, and draw several tickets at the end of the second day for major prizes. You do not have to be present to win. Our list of the demos will be published about one week in advance.

SEW 'TIL YOU DROP; MAY YOU FIND FABRIC IN NEED – "STUD MUFFIN":

STUD MUFFIN is our new sew-in evening event. We usually meet on the fourth Friday evening of each month for a potluck supper followed by sewing until we all drop.

The cost is \$5, and we encourage you to sign up no later than the preceding Wednesday. 17 people gathered for our first STUD MUFFIN, in June, and we all sewed on our most "in need" projects.

The upcoming dates are November 30, December 28, and January 25.

WE'VE GOT YOUR BACK: Bring in and show us your finished quilt top, and we shall give you a 20% discount on the cost of the fabric for the back. (This offer may not be combined with any other offers or discounts.)

MONDAY SEW-DAY: We have been asked to add daytime sewing days to our calendar – days when we can share the experience of sewing and quilting. During these days, we may sew on our own UFOs (unfinished objects), and perhaps also on charity quilts such as Quilts of Valor, quilts for kids in Title One programs, etc. In response, we are dedicating the first and third Mondays of each month. The classroom will open at 9:30 and be available all day. This program will begin on the third Monday of November, and the dates are November 19, December 3 and 17, and January 7 and 21. There is no cost.

THAI FABRIC CHALLENGE SHOW: Do you remember the Fabric Challenge Show last January, in which we were challenged to make quilts using the elephant motif fabric that Becky brought back from India? Becky is at it again, and has been joined by Nara Chong: They presented us with an entirely different set of fabrics - from Thailand - including silks. The show opens on January 2 and runs through Sunday, January 13. If you thought last year's show was special, wait until you see *this* show.

2019 SATURDAY SAMPLER – FALL'S MAJESTY: We have chosen Edyta Sitar's *Sew In Love* quilt; it measures 75" × 75". RJR fabrics from the *Fall's Majesty* collection are featured. The program starts on the second Saturday of January (the 12th), and runs for 13 months; in most months, you will make 4 blocks (an original and 3 copies). The registration fee is \$95; during the course of the program, you will receive 11½ yards of fabric. Your responsibility is to finish the assigned blocks and display them at the following meeting. The monthly "re-entry" fee for those unable to complete the assignment and display their blocks is \$10. Fabrics for the borders and binding are not included in the registration fee; we anticipate that these will cost about \$35 at the end of the program. You also will be expected to buy Edyta's book; the retail value is \$28.95, but we shall offer it to you at a 20% discount if you purchase it on or before December 15. We encourage you to sign up early, as the program will be limited to 50 people.

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2019 BLOCK OF THE MONTH PROGRAM: The 2019 Block of the Month program begins in January; watch your e-mail for the details.

FIRST FRIDAY SEW-IN: The dates are December 7, and January 4. (There is no First Friday Sew-In in November.) Join us at 5:30 for three hours in which we devote ourselves to *your* quilting projects. They can be UFOs, quilts on which you are “stuck”, etc. It is a full spectrum opportunity, all the way from the design of quilts to putting on the finishing touches. You are welcome to work on your own projects throughout the evening, and/or spend some time sewing (sharpening your skills, perhaps) on our charity quilts. There is no charge.

2018 ROW-BY-ROW EXPERIENCE™: The 2018 Row-by-Row program officially ends at the close of October. Starting on November 1, we are permitted to ship our pattern and/or our kit (including the pattern) in which Kokopelli plays his flute while resting against a treble clef in a background of New Mexico colors and motifs. Mr. Coyote raises his voice in the foreground, and a black wool mariachi hat with wonderful embroidery stitching rests jauntily on the top of the clef. Our *Sew Musical* Row measurers 12” x 27”.

Our pattern features wonderful threadwork, and not only details how to make the Row, but also has instructions for making it into a nice stand-alone wall hanging.

Our fabric license plate for 2018 reads: “DO MI SEW DO”, and has our Sunbonnet Sue logo. The background color for this year’s plate is terracotta, and the plate measures 7¼” x 3½”.

2015, 2016 AND 2017 ROW-BY-ROW EXPERIENCE™ PATTERNS: Patterns for our previous Rows are still available; you can buy the license plates for these years, too.

If you are new to quilting or want to sharpen some of your skills, we encourage you to go to our BASIC SKILLS CLASSES page. Our FAVORITE CLASSES have been offered before (in some cases, over and over!). The classes on our NEW CLASSES page are being offered for the first time in our shop (or offered again after a long hiatus).

DUKE CITY APPLIQUÉ SOCIETY: If your passion is hand appliqué, join us on the second Sunday of each month, 1:00-3:00. The dates are November 11, December 9, and January 13. VIQ (VERY IMPORTANT QUILTER) CARDS: Every time you purchase full-price merchandise valued at more than \$5, we stamp your VIQ card. Your completed VIQ card (\$250) is doubly valuable. A completed Card can be redeemed for \$25 toward the purchase of full-price merchandise. The redeemed cards are held until January 1 or July 1, at which time we draw one card, and present the winner with a gift card valued at \$75.00. (We do not stamp the VIQ cards for classes, half-priced merchandise, or sale purchases.)

BIRTHDAY DISCOUNT: Be sure to shop on your birthday: You will receive a 25% discount on all full-price merchandise purchased on that day. (Special arrangements will be made if your birthday falls on a day when the shop is closed.) We do not stamp your VIQ card when you take advantage of this discount.

STUDENT DISCOUNT COUPON – 20%: As an additional incentive to take classes at *The Quilt Works*, we offer Student Discount Coupons. This Coupon entitles you to a one-time 20% discount on full-price merchandise, and is valid for one month. You will receive this Coupon at the first class meeting. (*Basic Rotary Skills* and visiting instructor classes are excluded. VIQ cards are not stamped when you use the Student Discount Coupon.)

SENIOR DISCOUNT DAY: Don’t forget that each Tuesday is a “Senior Discount Day.” Your senior discount (for those 60 and older) is 10%. (VIQ cards are not stamped.)

GIFT CARDS: Gift Cards make great presents, and may be purchased at the front desk. You may choose any value for your card.

BASIC ROTARY SKILLS * LAURA ECHEVERRIA AND DANA BRABSON (This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.) Rotary cutting makes quilt making quick and enjoyable. This class will show you correct techniques.

Complete the class; then use \$10 of your class fee for any store purchase. 2 hrs: \$15.00.

LET'S GET STARTED * DANA BRABSON (This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.) Not sure about the "quilter's scant quarter inch" seam allowance? Need to know about "nesting seams"? Let's get started! This course takes you from the Basic Rotary Skills class to the Introduction to Machine Piecing class. We'll also learn about the quarter inch foot, the walking foot, and about the fabrics, threads, and batting that are best for your quilting project. Note: You must bring your own sewing machine to this class. 2½ hrs: \$20.00.

INTRODUCTION TO MACHINE PIECING * DANA BRABSON This basic class introduces you to machine piecing techniques and gives you the experience you need to take any other *Quilt Works* class. You make a different block in each of the first 4 classes, and then quilt and bind a placemat in the 5th class. The placemats are 18" × 12". If you choose to create a table runner with the 4 blocks, it is 63" × 18". A wall hanging with the 4 blocks finishes at 33" × 33", and can be used as a nice table topper. *The "Let's Get Started" class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for this class.* 10 hrs: \$80.00.

What could be easier than stitching along preprinted straight lines with your machine? When you have finished this little quilt, you will feel confident with any paper pieced pattern. Precutting is recommended. 3 hrs: \$25.50 (includes \$1.50 foundation papers)

ARROW ** LOIS WARWICK This is a spin on Bargello with strip sets and cut-to-size pieces. *Arrow* is an easy to cut and assemble small wall hanging (19½" x 31"). You can use conventional quilting techniques for making this project, or (as Lois did) use quilt-as-you-go methods. 3½ hrs: \$28.00.

BARGELLO HEART ** JEANETTE NAVA Come, let Jeanette show you how to make this heart Bargello quilt. It is made easily with strip construction. This quilt is a wonderful Valentine's Day quilt or a wedding gift for that special couple. 10 hrs: \$94.50 (includes the cost of the pattern, \$14.50).

CABIN FEVER ** BARBARA GARY This foundation paper pieced quilt is a good way to use the fat quarters in your stash. The 60" x 60" throw uses 25 light and 25 dark fat quarters. If you look closely, you will find that each block is a simple log cabin block in which the opposite corners have been replaced by paper-pieced quarters of circles. [PS. Save the leftover pieces from this project for the Judy Niemeyer quilt class that Barbara is planning to teach in February]. 12 hrs: \$96.00.

FABRIC SWAP QUILT ** MARGARET PRINA The fabric gives the quilt personality. Masculine, sophisticatedly easy, and fun to make. I love rectangles! 6 hrs: \$48.00.

FUN WITH WOOL ** MARY DEENEY This monthly wool embroidery class will explore many different embroidery stitches while you work to create a fun wool appliqué project. 9 hrs: \$72.00.

SALEM QUILT GUILD'S QUILT CAMPOUT ** KATHY CONGABLE The Salem Quilt Guild witches are back! This fun-loving group of quilting witches are getting together with their vintage trailers and having Quilting campouts for retreats. One block at a time is an easy approach to creating a large quilt. Recapture the joy of creating with color by joining us each month to explore how to embellish your blocks with simple embroidery stitches and colored pencils. Colored pencils open up a whole new world of creating texture on fabric by blending and smoothing the colors using different tools and techniques. We will begin each class with fun and easy coloring exercises to tint, color, and shade your fabric. Then we will trace and tint that month's block. Homework will consist of completing the embroidery for that month's block. At the end of the program you will have completed the quilt blocks made and have them ready to put together into a beautiful, and unique, quilt to display for Halloween or throughout the year. (NOTE: This is the first class of a 13-month program.)

We shall have something different each month as we explore the edges of our comfort zones. 6 hrs: \$48.00.

SANTA ANA WINDS * DANA BRABSON** The basic block in the Santa Ana Winds quilt has almost limitless possibilities for exciting designs. Dana has made the gentle curves easy to sew with room to trim down after sewing. After learning the basic techniques, we’ll spend time exploring some of the unique designs. The quilt may be made in any size, lap to king. A note from Becky Welch: I recently took this class and was blown away by the engineering of the templates, the block construction technique (there is a trick that makes it easier than it looks!), and especially the enormous design potential. This class should not be missed! 4½ hrs: \$36.00.

SUGAR * CINDY KUREY If you want to make something sweet-“Sugar” is the answer! Pull out those 5” charm squares you’ve been collecting and come make a unique ottoman for your sewing room or living space. Just like a real sugar cube. Making just one, may not be enough! 4 hrs: \$32.00.

T-SHIRT QUILT ** DANA BRABSON Think about those T-shirts from concerts you attended, from events in which you participated, from places you have been, etc. A T-shirt quilt will not only be a great memory piece or gift, but will also help you empty the drawers in which the shirts are “residents.” This is an A to Z technique class in which we imagine the design of the finished quilt, practice methods for stabilizing the T-shirt fabrics, explore the juncture between stabilized T-shirts and other fabrics, examine quilting ideas, and much more. 2½ hrs: \$20.00.

TUFFET ** CANDACE GILLIS Little Miss Muffet sat on a tuffet made from her favorite 2½ inch strips. No spiders – instead guidance from Candace to create this very special conversation piece for your front room.

Note (1): We offer the opportunity, at the same cost, to make a square Tuffet instead of the round Tuffet. The fabric requirements for the square Tuffet are different from those for the round Tuffet. Be sure to study the pattern in advance to make sure that you bring the right fabrics; Dana can help you with this.

Note (2): Sign up at least a week in advance so that we can order the hardware and other specialty items needed for this project. 6 hrs: \$48.00 for the class plus \$158.00 for the kit (VIQ eligible; includes pattern, hardware, and specialty fabrics).

WINTER TREES ** FAY MANGANELLI Follow clear and concise instructions to create your own tree landscape quilt. Fay will help you draft your pattern first – then assist with assembling and sewing.
