THE AUSSIE COLOR AND DESIGN ADVENTURE Have you ever wondered how quilt designers take fabrics from the bolt and piece them in excitingly imaginative new ways? We have a Meraki adventure for you. Lois Warwick will lead you in a creative, 45-minute new class at 8:30 on the first Saturday of each month, starting on the 4th of April. You will be given a fat eighth of one of our colorful Australian fabrics, assigned a traditional block, and challenged to choose complementary fabrics and create your own block, perhaps assembling the pieces in a uniquely different way.

Your "textbook" is Sue Voegtlin's marvelous book, *Block Genius, 201 Pieced Quilt Blocks*. Although you will recognize many of the blocks in this book, three are dozens of other designs, each thoroughly described, that you can incorporate in a sampler quilt of your own design.

Lois' display on the east wall of the classroom introduces you to five of the blocks that you will work with. Here, you can already see how rearrangement of the patches can create interesting, unique designs.

2020 SATURDAY SAMPLER PROGRAM: Imagine the scrappy throw that you might create if you were the wife of a gypsy and had colorful bits of fabric that we associate with the everyday life of a gypsy. Becky and Danyella are collaborating to lead you through this adventure in which you make lots of pieced blocks (that are fairly traditional) and set them together in an untraditional, modern setting.

The design, by Jen Kingwell, is called *Gypsy Wife*, measures 59" × 68", and has lots of half-seams and other fun piecing challenges.

The first sessions will be at 8:30 and 9:00 on April 11th. We shall meet on the second Saturday of the following months.

2020 BLOCK OF THE MONTH PROGRAM: Our 2020 Block of the Month is called *Star Sampler*, and is an original design, created for us, by Liz Whitehead. We have delayed the start of this 15 month program so that we may finish a shop model for you to see as you consider participating in this program; the first month will be June.

Star Sampler is 82" × 94", and features a large feathered star in the center. Surrounding the feathered star are the 12 different star blocks that you will make, month by month. The setting for these 13 blocks will keep you engaged for a while: There are 4 accent stars (designed by Deb), 160 Flying Geese patches, 2 sets of hen/chicks blocks, 4 half-claw blocks, 41 pinwheels and 41 colorful squares.

The monthly kits will be made exclusively with Batiks, and we offer two possibilities for the background fabric: one that is dark and one that is light. The shop model will have the dark background; but we are also making the feathered star feature block with a light background so that you can better decide which you prefer. We suggest that you buy all of the fabric required for the background at the beginning of the program since the Batik dying process rarely yields two bolts that are identical.

Since there are many different techniques used to make this quilt, Liz will be teaching a supplementary class each month to aid you in making this unique, queen-size, quilt. Her first class will be offered both in the afternoon, 1:00-3:30, and in the evening, 5:30-8:00, on Monday, June 29.

INFORMATION ABOUT OUR CLASSES: Descriptive information for all of our classes, along with dates and times, is included in this Newsletter. The same information, along with pictures of the Class Models, can be found on our website. The dropdown CLASSES menu at the top of our Home page will take you to 3 pages: BASIC SKILLS CLASSES, FAVORITE CLASSES, and NEW CLASSES. If you are new to quilting or want to sharpen some of your skills, we encourage you to go to our BASIC SKILLS CLASSES page. Our FAVORITE CLASSES have been offered before (in some cases, over and over!). The classes on our NEW CLASSES page are being offered for the first time in our shop (or offered again after a long hiatus).

OPEN SEWING DAYS

MONDAY SEW DAYS: Our beautiful new classroom is open for sewing each Monday at 9:30, and a group from the East mountains is already taking advantage of this opportunity. This is a great time to sew on UFOs (Unfinished Objects), get help on problem areas, work together on charity quilts, and simply share the quilting experience with other quilters.

THURSDAY SEW DAYS: The group that “christened” Monday Sew-Days has moved to the first and third Thursdays of each month, still meeting at 9:30. This group places special emphasis on Quilts of Valor, but you are welcome to join us and sew on other projects as well.

FIRST FRIDAY SEW-IN: Our First Friday Sew-Ins are similar to our Monday and Thursday Sew Days, except that we gather in the evening of the first Friday of each month. The dates are April 3, May 1 and June 5. Join us at 5:30 for three hours in which we devote ourselves to *your* quilting projects. They can be UFOs, quilts on which you are “stuck”, etc. It is a full spectrum opportunity, all the way from the design of quilts to putting on the finishing touches. You are welcome to work on your own projects throughout the evening, and/or spend some time sewing (sharpening your skills, perhaps) on our charity quilts. There is no charge.

QUILT SEW LATE - QSL: This is another opportunity to quilt with your friends. Quilt Sew Late starts when the shop closes at 5:30, on the last Friday of each month, includes a potluck supper, and does not end until the last quilter present unthreads his/her needle. The dates are April 24, May 29, and June 26. We usually work on our own projects but have charity quilts that need some work. The cost for the evening is \$5.00.

DUKE CITY APPLIQUÉ SOCIETY: If your passion is hand appliqué, join us on the second Sunday of most months, 1:00-3:00. Because of conflicts this quarter, the dates are April 5, May 17, and June 7. As the sponsoring organization for this meeting, we require that you join *The Appliqué Society* after two visits. For more information, go to <http://www.theappliquesociety.org/>

DISCOUNTS: Please choose the *one* discount that is appropriate for your purchase. Two (or more) discounts may not be applied to a single sales ticket. If you use your Student Discount Coupon, for example, we do not stamp your VIQ Card for that purchase.

VIQ (VERY IMPORTANT QUILTER) CARDS: Every time you purchase full-price merchandise valued at more than \$5, we stamp your VIQ card. Your completed VIQ card (\$250) is doubly valuable. A completed Card can be redeemed for \$25 toward the purchase of full-price merchandise. The redeemed cards are held until January 1 or July 1, at which time we draw one card, and present the winner with a gift card valued at \$75.00.

BIRTHDAY DISCOUNT: Be sure to shop on your birthday: You will receive a 25% discount on all full-price merchandise purchased on that day. (Special arrangements will be made if your birthday falls on a day when the shop is closed.)

STUDENT DISCOUNT COUPON – 20%: As an additional incentive to take classes at *The Quilt Works*, we offer Student Discount Coupons. This Coupon entitles you to a one-time 20% discount on full-price merchandise, and is valid for one month. You will receive this Coupon at the first class meeting. (*Basic Rotary Skills* and visiting instructor classes are excluded.)

SENIOR DISCOUNT DAY: Don’t forget that each Tuesday is a “Senior Discount Day.” Your senior discount (for those 60 and older) is 10%.

WE’VE GOT YOUR BACK: Bring in and show us your finished quilt top, and we shall give you a 20% discount on the cost of the fabric for the back.

LAST CHANCE: When a bolt of fabric has only a yard or so left, it becomes a candidate for our “Last Chance” basket. It doesn’t matter how old or new the fabric is; it can be a candidate. We bind the remaining fabric with a nice ribbon, and write the yardage on the tag; your discount is 30% of the price marked on the tag.

END OF THE BOLT: If you take all that remains on a bolt, regardless of the amount, your discount is 10%.

BASIC ROTARY SKILLS * LAURA ECHEVERRIA AND DANA BRABSON Rotary cutting makes quilt making quick and enjoyable. This class will show you correct techniques. Complete the class; then use \$10 of your class fee for any store purchase. *This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.*

LET'S GET STARTED * DANA BRABSON Not sure about the "quilter's scant quarter inch" seam allowance? Need to know about "nesting seams"? Let's get started! This course takes you from the Basic Rotary Skills class to the Introduction to Machine Piecing class. We'll also learn about the quarter inch foot, the walking foot, and about the fabrics, threads, and batting that are best for your quilting project. Note: You must bring your own sewing machine to this class. *This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.*

INTRODUCTION TO MACHINE PIECING * DANA BRABSON This basic class introduces you to machine piecing techniques and gives you the experience you need to take any other Quilt Works class. You make a different block in each of the first 4 classes, and then quilt and bind a placemat in the 5th class. The placemats are 18" × 12". If you choose to create a table runner with the 4 blocks, it is 63" × 18". A wall hanging with the 4 blocks finishes at 33" × 33", and can be used as a nice table topper. The "Let's Get Started" class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for this class.

We apply the binding to curved edges, create faux-mitered corners, and join the binding strips so that the joints are virtually bump-free. Then we add both a wide binding and a binding with a flange to our practice piece, and even learn how to apply a binding to the edge of a quilt with 90-degree notches around the edge.

T-SHIRT QUILT ** DANA BRABSON Think about those T-shirts from concerts you attended, from events in which you participated, from places you have been, etc. A T-shirt quilt will not only be a great memory piece or gift, but will also help you empty the drawers in which the shirts are “residents.” This is an A to Z technique class in which we imagine the design of the finished quilt, practice methods for stabilizing the T-shirt fabrics, explore the juncture between stabilized T-shirts and other fabrics, examine quilting ideas, and much more.
