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CLASSES SIGN UP DAYS: We shall discount by 10% the class fee for each class that you sign up for on or before Saturday, October 3.

CLOSURES: Thursday, November 26 (Thanksgiving Day), Friday, December 25 (Christmas Day), Friday, January 1 (New Year's Day).

We shall close at 2 pm, Wednesday, November 25 (Thanksgiving Eve); Thursday, December 24 (Christmas Eve), and Thursday, December 31 (New Year's Eve).

2020-2021 BLOCK OF THE MONTH PROGRAM: The quilt for our 2020-2021 Block of the Month program is called *Star Sampler*; it is an original design created for us by Liz Whitehead.

Although July was the first month of this program, you may join our program at any time; we shall have patterns and kits for all of the preceding months of the program throughout the entire program. (While the patterns for the current month are free, there is a charge for patterns published in the previous months. Kits for previous months include the patterns and do not have increased prices.)

Star Sampler is 92" x 104", and features a large feathered star in the center. Surrounding the feathered star are 12 different star blocks that you will make, month by month. The setting for these 13 star blocks will keep you engaged for a while: There are 4 accent stars, 178 Flying Geese patches, 2 sets of hen/chicks blocks, 4 half-claw blocks, and 43 pinwheels.

The monthly kits are made exclusively with Batiks. We offer two possibilities for the background fabric: dark and light. The shop model has the dark background; but we have also made the feathered star feature block with a light background so that you can better decide which you prefer. We suggest that you buy all of the fabric required for the background at the beginning of the program since the Batik dying process rarely yields two bolts that are identical.

Many different techniques are used to make this quilt, and Liz will be teaching a class each month with a focus on the techniques for that month. We recommend that you pick up your pattern or kit early in the month, study the pattern, and decide whether you wish to sign up for Liz's class for that month. Note that you sign up for one class at a time, month by month.

CLASS AND EVENT TIMES: Please note that several of the classes start at 9:30 am, Monday through Saturday (before the shop opens at 10:00 am). In addition, we have some classes and other events on Sunday mornings (again, when the shop is closed for normal business).

POLICIES FOR OPEN SEWING DAYS: In accord with the Governor's directives, only 6 people are permitted in the Classroom during normal shop hours, and 17 people at other times. To assure that these restraints are met, you must phone in advance to reserve your place in the Open Sewing Days event, and phone us if (at the last minute) you need to withdraw.

MONDAY SEW DAYS: 10 am to 4 pm, every Monday. Maximum participation: 6 people. This is a great time to sew on UFOs (Unfinished Objects), get help on problem areas, work together on charity quilts, and simply share the quilting experience with other quilters. The cost is \$5.00.

QUILTS OF VALOR SEW DAYS: 10 am to 4 pm, on the first and third Thursdays of each month. Maximum participation: 6 people. This group places special emphasis on Quilts of Valor, but you are welcome to join us and sew on other projects as well.

FIRST FRIDAY SEW-IN: 4:30 pm - 7:30 pm, first Friday of each month. Maximum participation: 17 people. Join us for three hours in which we devote ourselves to *your* quilting projects. They can be UFOs, quilts on which you are "stuck", etc. It is a full spectrum opportunity, all the way from the preliminary design to putting on the finishing touches. You are welcome to work on your own projects throughout the evening, and/or spend some time sewing (sharpening your skills, perhaps) on our charity quilts. There is no charge.

QUILT SEW LATE - QSL: 4:30 pm - ??? pm, October 30, November 20, and December 18. Maximum participation: 17 people. This is another opportunity to quilt with your friends. Given the COVID-19 concerns, we shall not have the traditional pot luck component, but invite you to bring your own evening fare. As before, the event does not end until the last quilter present unthreads his/her needle. We usually work on our own projects but have charity quilts that need some work. The cost for the evening is \$5.00.

“GYPSY WIFE”, THE SATURDAY SAMPLER PROGRAM:

Imagine the scrappy throw that you might create if you were the wife of a gypsy and had colorful bits of fabric that we associate with the everyday life of a gypsy. Becky and Danyella are collaborating to lead you through this adventure in which you make lots of (fairly traditional) pieced blocks and set them together in a modern setting. The design, by Jen Kingwell measures 59” × 68”, and has lots of half-seams and other interesting piecing challenges.

The program is being presented in two formats: one live, and one recorded. Ten participants are permitted to sign up for and view the live presentation at 9 am on the second Saturday of each month. This presentation is recorded and made available for viewing at home later in the day. All participants are able to view Becky’s and Danyella’s video tips as many times as they wish.

To receive the kit for the next month at no additional cost, you must show your completed current month’s work at the live presentation or bring it to the Shop any time during that weekend. Participants at a significant distance from the Shop (in Alaska, for example) may fulfill this requirement by emailing or texting pictures of their finished work to the Shop. As of this writing, we still have one vacancy in the program.

FREE SPIRIT TULA PINK “HOMEMADE” CHALLENGE:

In March, we received the complete Free Spirit Tula Pink HomeMade fabric collection, and announced that our shop is participating in the Challenge. Here is a brief outline of the Challenge, and the revised dates dictated by the COVID-19 situation.

1. The Quilt Works is a local sponsor of the Challenge. Participants are invited to display their entries at the Quilt Works during the month of October. One quilt will be selected from the displayed quilts and formally entered into the Challenge. The deadline for entering your quilt into the Challenge at the Shop is September 30.
2. Twelve quilts will be selected from the Nation-wide submissions for the HomeMade Challenge exhibit and trunk show, and will be displayed at the Fall International Quilt Market and Festival in Houston in October 2021.
3. The first prize has a retail value over \$10,000.
4. The quilt should be no smaller than 60” × 60”.
5. 80% (or more) of the quilt top must be made of fabrics from the Free Spirit HomeMade Tula Pink collection, and the finished work should include some Aurifil thread.
6. The quilt may be the work of more than one person, provided proper credit is given to all participants.

INFORMATION ABOUT OUR CLASSES: Descriptive information for all of our classes, along with dates and times, is included in this Newsletter. The same information, along with pictures of the Class Models, can be found on our website. The dropdown CLASSES menu at the top of our Home page will take you to 3 pages: BASIC SKILLS CLASSES, FAVORITE CLASSES, and NEW CLASSES. If you are new to quilting or want to sharpen some of your skills, we encourage you to go to our BASIC SKILLS CLASSES page. Our FAVORITE CLASSES have been offered before (in some cases, over and over!). The classes on our NEW CLASSES page are being offered for the first time in our shop (or offered again after a long hiatus).

THE OUTBACK (AUSSIE COLOR AND DESIGN) ADVENTURE:

Have you ever wondered how quilt designers take fabrics from the bolt and piece them in excitingly imaginative new ways? We have a Meraki (creative, artistic, “labor of love”) adventure for you. Lois Warwick will lead you in a creative, 45-minute new class at 9:00 on the following Saturdays, October 24, November 21, and December 19. You will be given a fat eighth of one of our colorful Australian fabrics, assigned a traditional block, and challenged to choose complementary fabrics and create your own block, perhaps assembling the pieces in a uniquely different way.

Your “textbook” is Sue Voegtlin’s marvelous book, *Block Genius, 201 Pieced Quilt Blocks*. Although you will recognize many of the blocks in this book, there are dozens of other designs, each thoroughly described, that you can incorporate in a sampler quilt of your own design.

Lois’s display on the east wall of the classroom introduces you to blocks that you will work with. You can already see how rearrangement of the patches can create interesting, unique designs.

Perhaps the most exciting times in an adventure (class?) such as this are the show-and-tell moments, when you see how the participants all created such different blocks. To enable lots of people to participate, we have chosen a low price point, \$8.00 per session, and selected a time (before the shop opens) when we can have 15 students, properly distanced in the Classroom.

DISCOUNTS: Please choose the *one* discount that is appropriate for your purchase. Two discounts may not be applied to the same item(s) on a sales ticket. If you use your Student Discount Coupon, for example, we do not stamp your VIQ Card for that purchase.

VIQ (VERY IMPORTANT QUILTER) CARDS: Every time you purchase full-price merchandise valued at more than \$5, we stamp your VIQ card. Your completed VIQ card (\$250) is doubly valuable. A completed Card can be redeemed for \$25 toward the purchase of full-price merchandise. The redeemed cards are held until January 1 or July 1, at which time we draw one card, and present the winner with a gift card valued at \$75.00. (We do not stamp the VIQ cards for classes, half-priced merchandise, or sale purchases.)

BIRTHDAY DISCOUNT: Be sure to shop on your birthday: You will receive a 25% discount on all full-price merchandise purchased on that day. (Special arrangements will be made if your birthday falls on a day when the shop is closed.)

STUDENT DISCOUNT COUPON – 20%: As an additional incentive to take classes at *The Quilt Works*, we offer Student Discount Coupons. This Coupon entitles you to a one-time 20% discount on full-price merchandise, and is valid for one month. You will receive this Coupon at the first class meeting. (*Basic Rotary Skills* and visiting instructor classes are excluded.)

SENIOR DISCOUNT DAY: Don’t forget that each Tuesday is a “Senior Discount Day.” Your senior discount (for those 60 and older) is 10%.

WE’VE GOT YOUR BACK: Bring in and show us your finished quilt top, and we shall give you a 20% discount on the cost of the fabric for the back.

LAST CHANCE: When a bolt of fabric has only a yard or so left, it becomes a candidate for our “Last Chance” basket. It doesn’t matter how old or new the fabric is; it can be a candidate. We bind the remaining fabric with a nice ribbon, and write the yardage on the tag; your discount is 30% of the price marked on the tag.

END OF BOLT: If you take all that remains on a bolt, regardless of the amount, your discount is 10%.

GIFT CARDS: Available, in any value, at the front desk.

CLASS POLICIES

You may register in person, by mail, or by phone using a credit card; the total class fee is due at time of registration. Class fees are non-refundable unless the class is cancelled by *The Quilt Works, Inc.*, or you notify us five (5) days in advance of the class.

PLEASE REVIEW YOUR CLASS SUPPLY LIST AND THE BASIC SEWING SUPPLY LIST. Be prepared to have fun in your class by having all your supplies. If you miss a class, a makeup is available for \$13/hour. Skill Level: * Beginner, no experience needed. ** Rotary skills and machine piecing experience are required. *** Advanced skills needed.

BASIC ROTARY SKILLS * LAURA ECHEVERRIA AND DANA BRABSON (This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.) Rotary cutting makes quilt making quick and enjoyable. This class will show you correct techniques.

Complete the class; then use \$10 of your class fee for any store purchase.

LET'S GET STARTED * DANA BRABSON (This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.) Not sure about the "quilter's scant quarter inch" seam allowance? Need to know about "nesting seams"? Let's get started! This course takes you from the Basic Rotary Skills class to the Introduction to Machine Piecing class. We'll also learn about the quarter inch foot, the walking foot, and about the fabrics, threads, and batting that are best for your quilting project. Note: You must bring your own sewing machine to this class.

INTRODUCTION TO MACHINE PIECING * DANA BRABSON This basic class introduces you to machine piecing techniques and gives you the experience you need to take any other *Quilt Works* class. You make a different block in each of the first 4 classes, and then quilt and bind a placemat in the 5th class. The placemats are 18" × 12". If you choose to create a table runner with the 4 blocks, it is 63" × 18". A wall hanging with the 4 blocks finishes at 33" × 33", and can be used as a nice table topper. *The "Let's Get Started" class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for this class.*

The quilt may be made in any size, lap to king. A note from Becky Welch: I recently took this class and was blown away by the engineering of the templates, the block construction technique (there is a trick that makes it easier than it looks!), and especially the enormous design potential. This class should not be missed.
