SEMI-ANNUAL SALE – MONDAY, JANUARY 18, THROUGH SUNDAY, JANUARY 24: In response to the COVID-19 situation, we have revised the format for the Semi-Annual Sale. We shall offer all regularly-priced, on-the-shelf merchandise at a 25% discount, all 7 days. In place of the Garage Sale, we shall offer all half-priced fabric at \$3.75/yd, all week long, and have many other items at "Garage Sale" prices, too.

STAR SAMPLER, THE 2020-2021 BLOCK OF THE MONTH

PROGRAM: We took a break and skipped December; we are back on track, and the January patterns and kits will be available on the 2nd. As always, the pattern for the current month's block is free, and the pattern for each of the prior months is available for \$6.

In addition to the kit for the current month, we have kits for most of the prior months. If you desire a kit for one (or more) of the prior months and cannot find it on the shelf, submit a Special Order at the front desk; at present, we have sufficient fabrics in stock to satisfy these Special Orders.

BOM Sew-In. If you would enjoy sharing your experience (or perhaps getting some help) with *Star Sampler*, we are offering a free Sew-In on Friday, 15 January, 5:30-8:30. The number of participants is limited by the COVID-19 precautions, so *please* call to reserve your space at least 2 days in advance.

Although the program started in July 2020, it is not too late to join. Here is a brief snapshot. *Star Sampler* is 92" x 104", and features a large feathered star in the center. Surrounding the feathered star are 12 different star blocks that you will make, month by month.

The monthly kits are made exclusively with Batiks. We offer two possibilities for the background fabric: dark and light. The shop model has the dark background; but we have also made the feathered star feature block with a light background so that you can better decide which you prefer.

QUILTS OF VALOR VIRTUAL SEW DAY: Saturday, 6 February. Last year, we sponsored a QOV Sew Day on the first Saturday of February. We are doing the same this year, with one change: It is a virtual event this year. Pat Forshaw is preparing kits for QOV blocks; you may pick up one (or several) kits at the shop, Monday through Friday, 1 – 5 February, and bring the finished blocks to the shop. The blocks will be sewn into QOV quilts during the Quilts of Valor Sew Days, the first and third Thursdays of each month, and presented to active duty and retired service members in honor of their service.

CLOSURES: Friday, January 1 (New Year's Day).

PROJECT LINUS SEW DAYS: Friday, January 8, 4:30-7:30, and Saturday, January 9, 10:00-4:00. Join us as we dedicate our January First Friday Sew-In, January 8, to Project Linus. We shall be sewing scrappy Disappearing 9-Patch blocks for Project Linus quilts, and encourage you to bring some of your own scraps ("Un-Stash") to include in these blocks.

We shall continue sewing for Project Linus on Saturday, January 9, and you are welcome to leave your machine set up Friday night if you desire to participate on both days.

We are limited to 6 sewers, so please sign up.

OPEN SEWING DAYS

POLICIES: In accord with the Governor's directives, only 6 people are permitted in the Classroom during normal shop hours and 11 people at other times. To assure that these restraints are met, you must phone in advance to reserve your place in the Open Sewing Days event, and phone us if (at the last minute) you need to withdraw.

MONDAY SEW DAYS: 10 am to 4 pm, every Monday (except the 18th of January). Maximum participation: 6 people. This is a great time to sew on UFOs (Unfinished Objects), get help on problem areas, work together on charity quilts, and simply share the quilting experience with other quilters. The cost is \$5.00.

QUILTS OF VALOR SEW DAYS: 10 am to 4 pm, on the first and third Thursdays of each month (except January, when it is on the first and fourth Thursdays). Maximum participation: 6 people. This group places special emphasis on Quilts of Valor, but you are welcome to join us and sew on other projects as well.

FIRST FRIDAY SEW-IN: 4:30 pm – 7:30 pm, first Friday of each month. Maximum participation: 11 people. Join us for three hours in which we devote ourselves to *your* quilting projects. They can be UFOs, quilts on which you are "stuck", etc. It is a full spectrum opportunity, all the way from the preliminary design to putting on the finishing touches. You are welcome to work on your own projects throughout the evening, and/or spend some time sewing (sharpening your skills, perhaps) on our charity quilts. There is no charge.

QUILT SEW LATE – QSL: 4:30 pm - ??? pm, January 29, February 26, and March 26. Maximum participation: 11 people. This is another opportunity to quilt with your friends. Given the COVID-19 concerns, we shall not have the traditional pot luck component, but invite you to bring your own evening fare. As before, the event does not end until the last quilter present unthreads his/her needle. We usually work on our own projects but have charity quilts that need some work. The cost for the evening is \$5.00.

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GYPSY WIFE, THE SATURDAY SAMPLER PROGRAM: Imagine the scrappy throw that you might create if you were the wife of a gypsy and had colorful bits of fabric that we associate with the everyday life of a gypsy. Becky and Danyella are collaborating to lead you through this adventure in which you make lots of (fairly traditional) pieced blocks and set them together in a modern setting. The design, by Jen Kingwell measures 59" × 68", and has lots of half-seams and other interesting piecing challenges.

We have changed from the dual-presentation format with which we started the program, to a virtual-only format. The presentation is recorded and made available for viewing at home. Participants are able to view Becky's and Danyella's video tips as many times as they wish.

To receive the kit for the next month at no additional cost, you may show your completed current month's work the Shop any time during the following week. Participants at a significant distance from the Shop (in Alaska, for example) may fulfill this requirement by emailing or texting pictures of their finished work to the Shop.

THE OUTBACK (AUSSIE COLOR AND DESIGN) ADVENTURE:

Have you ever wondered how quilt designers take fabrics from the bolt and piece them in excitingly imaginative new ways? We have a Meraki (creative, artistic, "labor of love") adventure for you. Lois Warwick leads you in a creative, 45-minute new class at 8:30 on the third Saturdays of each month. You will be given a fat eighth of one of our colorful Australian fabrics, assigned a traditional block, and challenged to choose complementary fabrics and create your own block, perhaps assembling the pieces in a uniquely different way.

Your "textbook" is Sue Voegtlin's marvelous book, *Block Genius, 201 Pieced Quilt Blocks*. Although you will recognize many of the blocks in this book, there are dozens of other designs, each thoroughly described, that you can incorporate in a sampler quilt of your own design.

Lois's display on the east wall of the classroom introduces you to blocks that you will work with. You can already see how rearrangement of the patches can create interesting, unique designs.

Perhaps the most exciting times in an adventure (class?) such as this are the show-and-tell moments, when you see how the participants all created such different blocks. To enable lots of people to participate, we have chosen a low price point, \$8.00 per session, and selected a time (before the shop opens) when we can have 10 students, properly distanced in the Classroom.

CLASSES SIGN UP DAYS: We shall discount by 10% the class fee for each class that you sign up for on or before Saturday, 09 January.

INFORMATION ABOUT OUR CLASSES: Descriptive information for all of our classes, along with dates and times, is included in this Newsletter. The same information, along with pictures of the Class Models, can be found on our website. The dropdown CLASSES menu at the top of our Home page will take you to 3 pages: BASIC SKILLS CLASSES, FAVORITE CLASSES, and NEW CLASSES. If you are new to quilting or want to sharpen some of your skills, we encourage you to go to our BASIC SKILLS CLASSES page. Our FAVORITE CLASSES have been offered before (in some cases, over and over!). The classes on our NEW CLASSES page are being offered for the first time in our shop (or offered again after a long hiatus).

DISCOUNTS: Please choose the *one* discount that is appropriate for your purchase. Two discounts may not be applied to the same item(s) on a sales ticket. If you use your Student Discount Coupon, for example, we do not stamp your VIQ Card for that purchase.

MILITARY DISCOUNT: To express our appreciation to those who have or are serving our country in the US armed forces (including the National Guard and the reserves), we offer a 10% discount to the member and his/her dependents on all full-price merchandise.

VIQ (VERY IMPORTANT QUILTER) CARDS: Every time you purchase full-price merchandise valued at more than \$5, we stamp your VIQ card. Your completed VIQ card (\$250) is doubly valuable. A completed Card can be redeemed for \$25 toward the purchase of full-price merchandise. The redeemed cards are held until January 1 or July 1, at which time we draw one card, and present the winner with a gift card valued at \$75.00. (We do not stamp the VIQ cards for classes, half-priced merchandise, or sale purchases.)

BIRTHDAY DISCOUNT: Be sure to shop on your birthday: You will receive a 25% discount on all full-price merchandise purchased on that day. (Special arrangements will be made if your birthday falls on a day when the shop is closed.)

STUDENT DISCOUNT COUPON – 20%: As an additional incentive to take classes at *The Quilt Works*, we offer Student Discount Coupons. This Coupon entitles you to a one-time 20% discount on full-price merchandise, and is valid for one month. You will receive this Coupon at the first class meeting. (*Basic Rotary Skills* and visiting instructor classes are excluded.)

SENIOR DISCOUNT DAY: Don't forget that each Tuesday is a "Senior Discount Day." Your senior discount (for those 60 and older) is 10%.

WE'VE GOT YOUR BACK: Bring in and show us your finished quilt top, and we shall give you a 20% discount on the cost of the fabric for the back.

LAST CHANCE: When a bolt of fabric has only a yard or so left, it becomes a candidate for our "Last Chance" basket. It doesn't matter how old or new the fabric is; it can be a candidate. We bind the remaining fabric with a nice ribbon, and write the yardage on the tag; your discount is 30% of the price marked on the tag.

END OF BOLT: If you take all that remains on a bolt, regardless of the amount, your discount is 10%.

CLASS AND EVENT TIMES: Please note that several of the classes start at 9:30 am, Monday through Saturday (before the shop opens at 10:00 am). In addition, we have some classes and other events on Sunday mornings (again, when the shop is closed for normal business).

GIFT CARDS: Great Holiday presents!

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BASICS, BASICS, BASICS

CLASS POLICIES: You may register in person, by mail, or by phone using a credit card; the total class fee is due at time of registration. Class fees are non-refundable unless the class is cancelled by *The Quilt Works, Inc.*, or you notify us five (5) days in advance of the class. PLEASE REVIEW YOUR CLASS SUPPLY LIST AND THE BASIC SEWING SUPPLY LIST. Be prepared to have fun in your class by having all your supplies. If you miss a class, a makeup is available for \$13/hour. Skill Levels:
* Beginner, no experience needed. ** Rotary skills and machine piecing experience are required. *** Advanced skills needed.

BASIC ROTARY SKILLS * LAURA ECHEVERRIA AND DANA BRABSON (This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.) Begin your quilting experience with patches that are exactly the right size. In this class, we introduce you to the wide spectrum of rotary cutters, rulers and mats that are available, and to the techniques that enable you to cut fabric patches with accuracy and precision. Complete the class; then use \$10 of your class fee for any store purchase.

LET'S GET STARTED * DANA BRABSON (This class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for all machine classes.) Not sure about the "quilter's scant quarter inch" seam allowance? Need to know about "nesting seams"? Let's get started! This class takes you from the Basic Rotary Skills class to the Introduction to Machine Piecing class. We'll also learn about the quarter inch foot, the walking foot, and about the fabrics, threads, and batting that are best for your quilting project. Note: You must bring your own sewing machine to this class.

INTRODUCTION TO MACHINE PIECING * DANA BRABSON This basic class introduces you to machine piecing, quilting and finishing techniques, and gives you the experience you need to take any other *Quilt Works* class. You make a different block in each of the first 4 classes, and then quilt and bind a placemat in the 5th class. The placemats are 18" × 12". If you choose to create a table runner with the 4 blocks, it is 63" × 18". A wall hanging with the 4 blocks finishes at 33" × 33", and can be used as a nice table topper. *The "Let's Get Started" class, or equivalent experience, is a prerequisite for this class.*

BASIC HAND QUILTING * MARGARET PRINA Learn the art of quilting by hand. We provide you with a marked top for quilting. Needles and hoops are available to try out.

Beginning Machine Quilting I is a prerequisite for this class. Learn the art of free-motion quilting. Becky will demonstrate the use of stencils, marking, and quilting without marking. Specialty threads will also be discussed.

BINDING BASICS * DANA BRABSON Your project is quilted and needs a binding. Learn how to apply a binding by machine. We apply the binding to curved edges, create faux-mitered corners, and join the binding strips so that the joints are virtually bump-free. Then we add both a wide binding and a binding with a flange to our practice piece, and even learn how to apply a binding to a quilt with 90-degree notches around the edge.

A note from Becky Welch: *I recently took this class and was blown away by the engineering of the templates, the block construction technique (there is a trick that makes it easier than it looks!), and especially the enormous design potential. This class should not be missed.*
